

John Murchison and son Reid Murchison, president in 1998. Their uncle and great uncle, John R. Murchison, was our club's first president in 1915.







Bobby Greer, right, is the son of Gardner Greer, secretary/treasurer of our club from 1944-46.














David Jones and Wilbur Jones are first cousins






